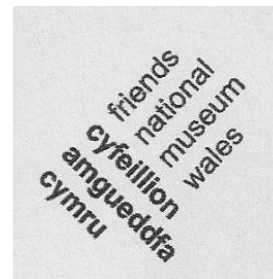

**An opportunity to have a guided tour of St Fagans in the company of Rhiannon Thomas the Learning, Participation and Interpretation Manager @ Amgueddfa Cymru - National Museum Wales.

PROGRAMME: 10.30am – 11am meet and greet in Studio 1 which is in the Weston Centre for learning upstairs from the new entrance hall at St Fagans National History Museum. Here coffee/teas and biscuits will be provided. **At 11.00am** we will commence the guided tour of the new galleries. **At 1pm** we return to the room for lunch. This will consist of a Drovers' Platter of Carmarthen sliced ham, Welsh cheese, chutney, grapes and celery, with bread and butter and a home-made lemonade. Coffee/tea will also be available. Please let me know if you have any special dietary requirements. **At about 2pm** we will walk to the **Gweithdy Gallery** which is a special space where you can celebrate the skills of makers across millennia. At the edge of the woodland, this stunningly designed eco-friendly building is both a gallery and a craft workshop. We then will move on to **Llys Llywelyn** which is a recreation of a Royal Court of the Princes of Gwynedd used during the 13th century. It is based on the surviving remains of Llys Rhosyr in the south-western corner of Anglesey and was excavated by the Gwynedd Archaeological Trust between 1992 and 1996.

Please be aware that this visit will involve some walking so wear stout shoes and check the weather forecast for rain as you will be out of doors in the afternoon as you walk to the venues. We will be a small group and Rhiannon will be wearing a microphone.

THE TOTAL CHARGE for the day includes; morning coffee/tea/biscuits, a ploughman's lunch with lemonade and tea/coffee, and a guided tour. Please note there is a charge for parking which is £5 which you will have to pay yourself. If you have problems getting to St Fagans please inform us and we might be able to organise a lift.
