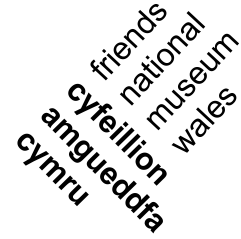

A VISIT TO THE NATIONAL COLLECTIONS CENTRE OF THE MUSEUM

Friends will be aware that most major museums hold artefacts etc too numerous for all to be exhibited at the same time. The purpose of the Collections Centre is to undertake curatorial care, management, and conservation of the wide variety of such items.

The visit will encompass a wide-ranging insight into the work of the Centre and will therefore be of greater interest than the standard public offering. On arrival there will be an introductory talk by Diane Gwilt, Keeper of Collection Services, with coffee/tea being served. A tour highlighting aspects of the Centre's work likely to be of interest to Friends, including the transport section, the visit will extend to approximately two hours in duration..

Numbers will be restricted to 40. The visit will of necessity involve limited availability of seating and (while wholly under cover) will involve entry to unheated parts of the Centre.

Coming from Cardiff on the A470 one should take A468 for Parc Nantgarw, where the Centre is opposite Peacocks. Ample free parking is available at the Centre.
