A VISIT TO OXFORD
WEDNESDAY 13TH APRIL 2022

We shall set down at the Ashmolean Museum where a major exhibition of works by Camille Pissarro, one of the original impressionists will be on display. This exhibition drawn from the Ashmolean's collections as well as international loans will span Pissarro's entire career. Bookings for entrance are recommended and the weekday price applies to our visit, which is £13.50 (£15.00 with Gift Aid).

Why not visit the Oxford Botanic Garden if the weather is favourable? This is a pleasant 20 minute walk along High Street towards Magdalen College, and is the oldest botanic garden in the U.K., founded in 1621 as a physic garden growing plants for medicinal research.

Oxford University Museum of Natural History is a fine example of 19th century architecture and is as spectacular today as when it opened in 1860. The Oxford University Museum gives access to the Pitt Rivers Museum next door. This houses the University's collections of zoological, entomological, paleontological and mineralogical specimens accumulated in the course of the last three centuries. Both museums are free and there is no need to book.

The programme for the day is as follows:

- 8.30 am. Depart National Museum Cathays Park.
- 8.45 am. Depart Wild Gardens Road, Roath Park.
- 11.00 am. Arrive at the Drop-off/Pick-up Point, The Ashmolean Museum.
- 5.00 pm Coach will depart for Cardiff.

The total charge for the day which includes the coach & driver's gratuity is £27.00.
