

Tyntesfield was bought by William Gibbs in 1843. From 1863 the existing Georgian house was remodelled according to Gothic Revival principles and a symbol of his Anglo-Catholic Faith.

Today
Tyntesfield contains over 60,000 objects accumulated by William Gibbs and his Heirs, from celebrated paintings and ornate furnishings to the more mundane domestic objects.

## **Chepstow:**

Here we are able to lunch in one of the many restaurants and after lunch you may like to visit one of the several places of interest: St Mary's Priory the earliest example of Romanesque architecture in Wales. The Medieval Castle that was built in the seventh century or there is the Chepstow Museum. Some of you might just like to take leisurely stroll around the town.
