Organ Concerts 2024

The Friends' donation to Amgueddfa Cymru has sponsored these concerts and you now have the opportunity to hear a programme of recitals played on this beautiful organ.



The organ was made by Snetzler in 1774 for Sir Watkin Williams Wynn, for his London house at 20, St James's Square. It was altered by Samuel Green in 1783 and then moved to the Williams Wynn country seat at Wynnstay Hall near Ruabon in 1863 where it was rebuilt by Gray & Davison. It was restored again in 1996, more or less unaltered, though the Swell, which at Wynnstay had been placed in an alcove behind the organ was placed in the normal position in the more compact form necessary in the Museum.
