Michael Sheen leads in the title role in this play which charts the life and legacy of Welsh Labour MP Aneurin 'Nye' Bevan, most noted for being the Minister of Health who led to the establishment of the National Health Service.

Wales Millennium Centre and the National Theatre in London have announced this new play to be performed first in London and then in Cardiff. It is written by Welsh playwright and screenwriter Tim Price and directed by the National Theatre's Artistic Director. The play takes the form of Nye Bevan looking back at his life.

If you were/are in the medical profession, if you are a socialist, if you are interested in the history of the NHS or just like seeing new slants on familiar topics, this will be a fascinating insight into how the NHS was set up and the man who actually completed the task.
