Ludlow and Berrington Hall Wednesday 2th July 2025

The townscape of **Ludlow**, is based on original medieval town plan and has fine examples of architecture from the Medieval, Tudor and Georgian periods. Foremost among these buildings are Ludlow Castle which Roger de Lacy began constructing in about 1057 and the Parish Church of St Laurence built in 1199. There are nearly 500 listed buildings, a Market Square with a market on Wednesdays and many historic inns, taverns, restaurants and cafés offering refreshments.

Berrington Hall, designed by Henry Holland and built for Sir Thomas Harley in 1781, is a fine example of a neoclassical country house with Lancelot 'Capability' Brown parkland and pleasure grounds. This was his last masterpiece before his death in 1783. The fourteen-acre serpentine lake, also designed by Brown, is a registered Site of Special Scientific Interest is home to a colony of herons who return to breed very spring.
