Marion came to Wales to study at Aberystwyth University, married a Welshman, learned Welsh and now speaks fluent Welsh as well as English, German and a number of other languages. She is Head of History at Cardiff University and researches and teaches Wales's cultural, political and religious connections with the wider world. She is the author of ***The Literary and Historical Legacy of Iolo*** and her work continues to focus on the eisteddfod and on Iolo Morganwg's legacy.
